Scottsdale's Greenlight Communities hits \$100,000 mark for charitable giving

Scottsdale-based Greenlight Communities, a developer focusing on providing attainable rental housing to communities across Arizona, has given over \$100,000 since starting its Greenlight Gives initiative in recent years.
